Get a Quote on Your Wood Tops

- 1, Draw and dimension the countertops. Note any cutouts (sinks, grommets, etc.) and any finished edges.
- 2, Identify the type of wood top (plank, veneer, butcherblock or laminate).
- 3, Identify the wood species (if you're not sure, use descriptors like blonde, caramel, cherry, mahogany, umber).
- 4, For plank top, identify tungsten oil or varnish/stain finish.
- 5, Identify desired thickness and edge shape (square, bullnose, bevel, ogee or complex).
